Opportunities:


- Groupwork based on business simulation.

- Improve leadership, communication and teamworking skills
- For University and Industrial staff to work together on course delivery.

- To identify how to improve the course delivery.
- To identify why difficulties identified in certain groups and try to prevent these in future.


How many methods did groups use to communicate with each other?



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Which methods were used to communicate within group?




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
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How many methods did groups use to communicate with teaching staff?

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Key findings – Students Perceptions

- Importance of communication skills in managing teams.
- The staff is seen as a team University and Business Simulation Provider.
- Quick response to queries is valued.
- Different communication channels are used for different purposes.
- Accessibility of staff is important and there is a demand for more



Key findings – Teaching Staff

- Challenges of running an integrated team of teaching staff.
- Need for a quick response to prevent group issues escalating.
- Can use elearning environments to complement class teaching.
- Challenges of providing quick response to queries and balancing staff workload.
- Identifying which communication mechanism is more effective for what purpose is important.
